

In a wild whisper you spoke to chaos, God of the waters of life, and your Spirit raced forth, playing tag with the Word, mountains shook with thunder, whales whispered in the oceans, hawks floated lazily in the skies, and kittens chased butterflies in fields. You created us from the dusty earth, placing us in your garden of wonders so we might delight in you, and in each other. But we wandered away from you, as sin and death took us by the hand, teaching us to do all that is wrong. Prophets came in every age to testify about your hopes, but we did not want to be set free from our captivity. So Jesus was sent, your future coming over the horizon to us to be baptized as your Beloved. With those who bend but do not break, with those who long to do what is right,

Why is there a place setting in the Sanctuary sometimes? On Communion Sundays it's a reminder that we all get hungry and we all need to eat. For some, having 3 square meals a day isn't easy or even doable. The Community Café helps by offering free dinner and dessert. We take an extra collection on Communion Sundays to cover the cost of our Church's monthly donation pizza, salad, and ice cream that we provide for 60 or more. Our delivery on the 4th Monday of every month, costs about \$147:00.
