

Why is there a place setting in the Sanctuary sometimes? On Communion Sundays it's a reminder that we all get hungry and we all need to eat. For some, having 3 square meals a day isn't easy or even doable. The Community Café helps by offering free dinner and dessert. We take an extra collection on Communion Sundays to cover the cost of our Church's monthly donation of pizza, salad, and ice cream that we provide for 60 or more. Our delivery on the 4th Monday of every month costs about \$147.00.
